The most destructive earthquake is known to be that of 1303 from the Greek island of Crete. The last remains of the lighthouse disappeared in 1480 when the Sultan of Egypt, Qaitbay, ordered the construction of a medieval fort on the platform where the lighthouse stood. A total of 12 years were needed for completion of the entire building and total 800 silver talents were used. The lighthouse was used, like the sun day and the night fire, to make sure that the sailors could surf security in hazardous waters. In 1994, the French archaeologist Jeans-Yves Empereur discovered the physical remains of Alexandria's lighthouse on the floor of the eastern Port of Alexandria. The shipment was driven by Honor Frost on the Lighthouse website; Frost confirmed the existence of ruins that represented part of the lighthouse. The lighthouse was built with large light color blocks. Most of the findings consisted in gigantic granite blocks of the weight of 40-60 tones each, 30 pavel statues and 5 obelisk columns that reign sculptures dated to Ramses II in 1279-1213 A.C.
